

2022 Leaf Pickup

The City of Robins has contracted with Jordan's Property Care (Contractor) for the 2022 Fall Leaf Pickup Program.

The leaf pickups are tentatively scheduled for the weeks of October 24th and November 28th. Since it is not known exactly where they will be picking up on which day, it is **VERY** important that you have your leaves ready for pickup on Monday morning by 7:00 a.m. as the pickups will begin on Monday morning.

The terms of the agreement are as follows:

- A. The Contractor will collect loose leaves, which have been raked to the street curbside in the designated residential areas within the corporate city limits of Robins starting **Monday October 24th, 2022** and **Monday November 28th, 2022**.
- B. The Contractor will use vacuum trucks and vacuum trailers each of the two designated weeks in order to affect the loose leaf vacuum collection service.
- C. The collection will be provided in the residential areas of Robins. No commercial, retail or industrial businesses, properties with 4 or more units, schools or other institutions will be eligible for the collection service.
- D. Loose leaves **MUST** be ready for collection by 7:00 AM on Monday of each of the designated collection weeks. **If the vacuum trucks pass your residence and the leaves are not on the curb, you must wait until the next collection date, weather permitting.**
- E. Loose leaves will not be collected in alleys or on private drives or driveways.
- F. Loose leaves should **NOT** be raked into the street.
- G. Loose leaves must be raked into long rows parallel to the edge of the road, not into piles. They shall be within 5 feet of the edge of the road but remain on the grass area next to the curb or roadside.
- H. Loose leaves **MUST BE FREE OF BRUSH AND BRANCHES AND ANY OTHER OBSTACLES!! (They will damage the vacuum)** If piles are mixed the leaves will not be collected and crews will not come back until the next scheduled collection day, weather permitting.
- I. Vehicles **must not** be parked in front of the leaf windrows on the designated collection days. If leaf rows are blocked by parked vehicles, they will not be picked up and crews will not return until the next scheduled collection day.
- J. If the November 28th collection is delayed due to inclement weather the City will discuss an alternate date for the second collection.

This is a service that is being paid for by the City of Robins (in other words your tax dollars) and approved by the Mayor and City Council. We are asking for your cooperation and feed-back. The feedback from prior years was positive and seen as a good solution to our yearly fall leaf problem.
